# **Semi-Annual Convention**

Our semi-annual convention was held on September 22<sup>nd</sup> at Peace Lutheran Church. Grant Schmidt from the Norfolk office gave a very informative address about what is going on for OGT. Grant and Gary Wieck spoke about the formation of a new OGT branch organization in Panama. The Panama Branch will enable OGT to distribute goods throughout Central and South America.

Additionally, Grant talked about a new project in St. Petersburg, Russia called Hanna House. It will be a halfway house for girls leaving orphanages in Russia. All children in Russian orphanages are required to leave at age 18. Hanna House will allow the girls to receive some kind of vocational training and life skills for living on their own. Currently many of those girls fall victim to drug and sex trafficking because the girls have no support system. Hanna House was something that Pastor Reehl had wanted to establish for some time. His daughter Karen and three other people traveled to St. Petersburg to meet with Lutheran church officials to get this new home established. Please keep the Hanna House project in your prayers.

Al & Bev Nixon from Kenesaw won this year's convention quilt that was raffled off. Al & Bev, along with several other members of their church, are monthly volunteers at the warehouse.

While the convention attendance was down significantly from past years, we still raised about \$4,700 from the quilt raffle, silent and live auctions and the freewill offering for the noon meal.
