News We'd Rather Not Need to Share

For the past year, Orphan Grain Train--Michigan has anticipated a support shipment of churchly and humanitarian goods to the Evangelical Lutheran

Church of South Sudan. (ELCSS/S).

Over the course of this year hundreds of theological books packaged in over 120 cases have been gathered for establishing a Lutheran seminary library in Yambio. We also have in our warehouse baptismal fonts, hundreds of choir robes, altar ware, and multiple other ecclesiastical goods fully ready for a shipment which now is being prevented by circumstances beyond our control.

Plans for this effort have been made in collaboration with LUTHERAN HERITAGE FOUNDATION. But sadly we have encountered barriers making a distribution at this time too difficult to complete.

- --- Import regulations in South Sudan have become a great obstacle
- --- Multiple freight forwarders are unable to undertake our intended shipment.
- --- Other complexities are outside the established and necessary practices of Orphan Grain Train.

We have no choice but to suspend this effort. We had hoped to ship earlier this Fall, but sometimes even the best intentions simply can't be realized....


