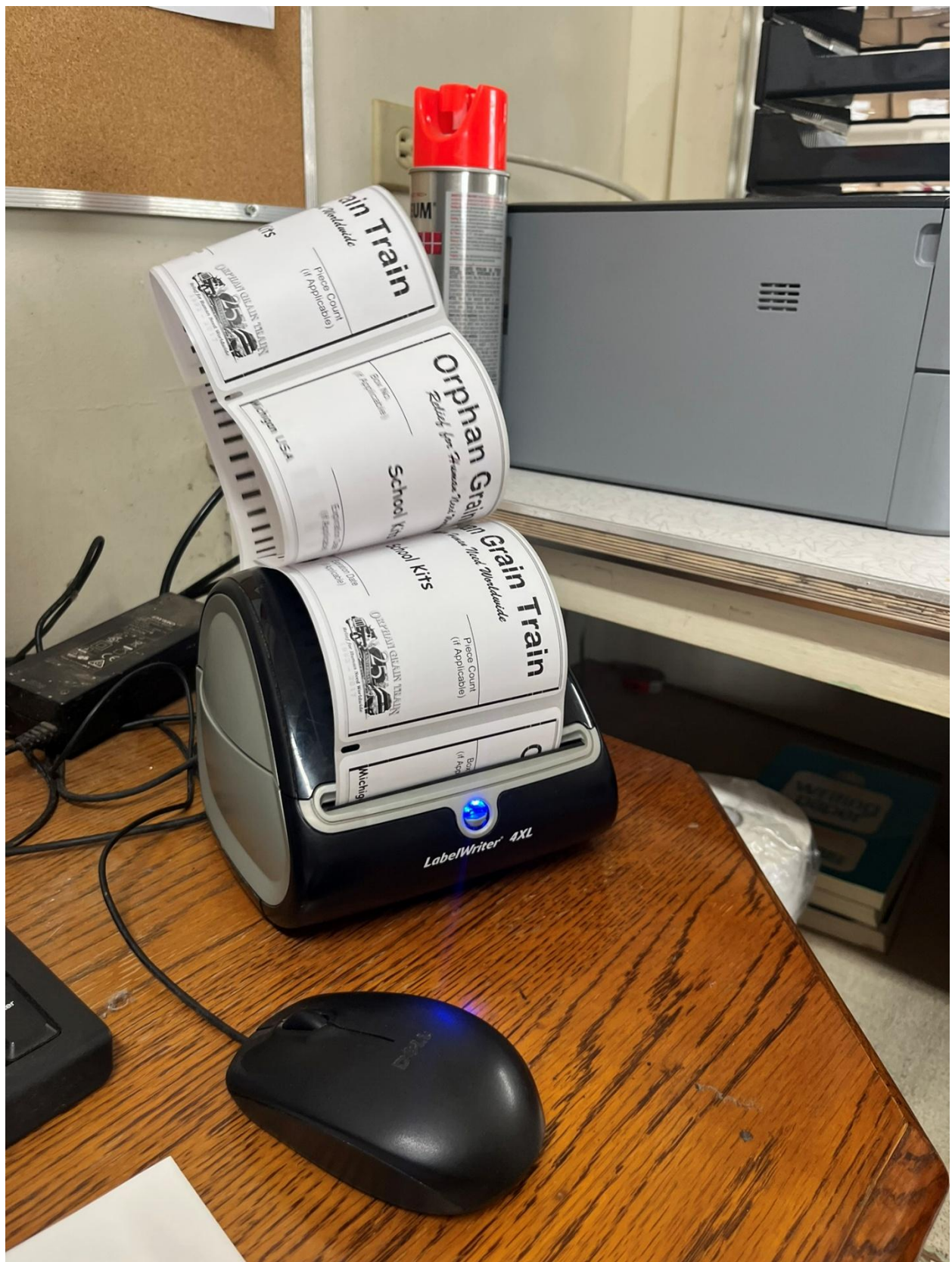


Beautiful Offering
