October started very well. Mary Gonzalez brought in 18 boxes of medical supplies.



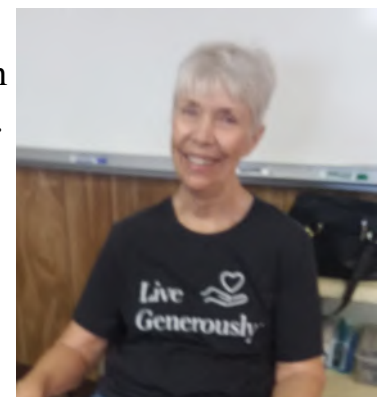
