The situation is dire in Kentucky and they are in need of supplies ASAP. Please consider helping as you are able.

Plus order Thrivent T-shirts, 25 per project, as well as the stickers to put on the kits we are sending. To speed things up put: TORNADO 2021 for the code.

NO USED CLOTHES

NEW: Children winter jackets, gloves, hats, scarves

NOAA alert radios

Storage totes

Laundry baskets and detergent



**Adult and Children/infant disposable diapers
Bibles and prayer shawls**

ALSO NEEDED: Any items in the health kits or school kits as indicated below

HEALTH/HYGIENE KITS

- Bath towels and washcloths
- Bars of soap
- Toothbrushes (individually wrapped)
- Toothpaste
- Deodorant
- Sturdy combs
- Nail Clippers
- Band-aids
- Tissues (pocket-sized)

SCHOOL SUPPLIES KIT

- Backpack or drawstring bags (Must accommodate spiral notebooks)
- notebooks and folders
- blunt scissors and ruler
- pens and pencils
- erasers and pencil sharpeners
- boxes of 24 crayons

PLEASE stick to the lists and DO NOT substitute any items.

Donations may be dropped off at the OGT warehouse each Monday and Tuesday morning from 9:00 to noon and Tuesday evenings from 5:00 to 7:00 pm. In addition, the warehouse will be open this Saturday, January 8th, from 9:00 to noon.

A group of volunteers will be assembling hygiene kits and school kits at the OGT warehouse each Tuesday morning, January 11th, 18th, and 25th. Feel free to join us if you'd like to help.
