The Central Iowa Branch is located in Clemons, Iowa. The facility includes what was 10 class rooms as well as a modern cafeteria, gymnasium, and bus barn. The facility was originally part of the West Marshall School district, and then in 1978, the buildings and ground were purchased by three members of St. John Lutheran Church. Beginning in 1980 and continuing until 2014, it was home to Clemons Lutheran School until it closed due to enrollment. Beginning in August of 2015 the facility, now owned by Orphan Grain Train, Inc, has been home to the Central Iowa Branch.

#### WHAT INTRIGUES YOU ABOUT OGT?

In these short seven years we have been able to ship twenty-one loads of humanitarian supplies of clothing and medical supplies to places a few miles away and also around the world.

One of the most remarkable things concerning these shipments is the ability of the OGT Norfolk office to arrange for all of the shipping details, from the recipients, to the trucks and drivers, to finding empty shipping containers, to getting them by rail to shipping ports, to getting them booked on the ocean vessels, and then by truck again to the final recipients.

Another thing that we do is to make our cafeteria and gym available to local people and families for holiday parties, town celebrations, fund raisers and even wedding receptions. Not many towns of only 140 people have these things available to them for basically the cost of lights and heat.

Our branch officers include Trisha Adams, manager; Richard Hartwig, assistant manager; Bonnie Berrey, secretary; and Julie Wengert, treasurer. None of our loads would be possible without our regular packers and sorters who meet every Tuesday morning from 8:00 am till noon, and to our many generous donors and supporters. We thank God for their dedication and willingness to serve others.
