Weekly Devotion

There are those who rebel against the light, who do not know its ways or stay in its paths. (Job 24:13)

Context: In Job Chapter 24, Job is responding to the accusations of Eliphaz, one of his so-called friends.

Devotional Thoughts: If anyone had reason to feel totally oppressed & overwhelmed by darkness in his life, it was Job. God allows Satan to destroy all of Job's property, take away his children, & afflict him with sores. Three of Job's "friends" arrive, but instead of speaking words of comfort & consolation, mostly they accuse Job of sinful behavior that must have brought God's wrath upon him. Even Job's wife tells Job to curse God & die.

In the midst of his trials, Job recognizes that "*there are those who rebel against the light, who do not know its ways or stay on its paths.*" I believe that Job must have been speaking of the "*light*" of God. The *Book of Job* has a happy ending. After God speaks harsh words to Job, Job acknowledges that he truly cannot hope to comprehend the power & wisdom of God. God restores all of Job's possessions & blesses him with more children.

Prayer: Deliver us, O God, from the darkness in our lives & in the lives of our loved ones, always according to Your will. Use the trials we encounter to strengthen our faith in You. Shine Your light into our darkness. We ask this in Your Son's name. Amen.
