Weekly Devotion

For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light (for the fruit of the Spirit consists in all goodness, righteousness & truth) & find out what pleases the Lord. Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them. For it is shameful even to mention what the disobedient do in secret. But everything exposed by the light becomes visible, for it is light that makes everything visible. This is why it is said, "Wake up, O sleeper, rise from the dead, & Christ will shine on you." (Eph. 5:8-14)

Light vs Dark: Have you ever been in a cave when the lights were turned off? Deep in the recesses of the cavern it's so dark that you cannot see your hand even when it's inches from your face. It's very disconcerting! It's a genuine relief when the lights are turned back on again, & you can safely make it back to the surface. The Apostle Paul talks about the present darkness in which we live. It doesn't take much looking around to discover "the fruitless deeds of darkness." It's an apt metaphor for our sinful world, where those living in darkness cannot see their hands in front of their faces.

We are called to live in the light. We are called to be "light in the Lord." We are encouraged to "find out what pleases the Lord." Where do we find out what pleases the Lord? The answer is found in Holy Scripture. But we remember that our good deeds don't earn us God's favor & love. They are a reflection of His love for us. Jesus said, "In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see Your good deeds & praise your Father in heaven." (Matt. 5:16)

Today's Prayer: Thank You, Jesus, for shining Your light into our dark world. Bless us to live as children of light. Amen.
