Weekly Devotion

Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil. After fasting forty days & forty nights, He was hungry. (Matt. 4:12) **Fasting:** Many people, even Lutherans fast, especially during Lent. It is a valuable spiritual discipline. Some fast by eating only fish on Fridays. I went to a Lutheran grade school in an overwhelmingly Lutheran town. Yet on every Friday during Lent, we were served fish sticks as part of our school lunch. I asked my dad, who was principal, why we had fish sticks on these Fridays. It turns out that one of our food vendors was Catholic & gave us a discount on fish sticks. *Matthew 4:1-11* is the account of Jesus' temptation by the devil in the wilderness. Jesus fasted "forty days & forty nights." Of course, "He was hungry!" And Satan's first temptation was directed at our Savior's hunger. "The tempter [Satan] came to (Jesus) & said, 'If You are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread." (Matt. 4:3) This was the first of three temptations. "Jesus answered, 'It is written: Man does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God." (4:4) Jesus was quoting from Deut. 8:3. Each time Jesus was tempted, He countered with the Word of God. Finally, He said to the devil, "Away from Me, Satan! For it is written: 'Worship the Lord your God & serve Him only!'" (Matt. 4:10) Satan works overtime to put temptations in our way. Without God's grace we could not stand up to these temptations. Hebrews 4:15 says, "For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet was without sin." The first Messianic promise in Scripture is found in Genesis 3:15, where God says to the serpent, Satan, "And I will put enmity between you & the woman, & between your offspring & hers; He will crush your head, & you will strike His heel." The devil struck Jesus a glancing blow when He was nailed to the cross. Jesus "crushed" Satan by dying & rising again to save us. **Prayer Prompts:** Ask God to lead you not into temptation but deliver you from evil.
