Orphan Grain Train's Fiscal Year was June 1, 2025 to May 31, 2026.

290 full shipments (40
or 53 ft. containers) of
donated relief supplies and
food were shipped within
the United States and
internationally.

More than \$41.8 million
worth of donated
humanitarian aid, food and
disaster relief assistance
was distributed.

Total of 179,368.15
volunteer hours were
given with a value of
\$2,152,417.80 if paid
\$12/hour.

More than 8.8 million Mercy
Meals, Kids Against Hunger,
Harvest Pack, Manna Pack,
Food for Kidz, Many Hands
Many Meals & Love the
Hungry meals were
shipped worldwide.

26 regional OGT locations
from California to
