OGT Houston Sends First International Shipment!















December 13, 2025, marks the day Orphan Grain Train Houston sent out their first international shipment. These are photos of that milestone day.

With the help of many energetic volunteers, Orphan Grain Train Houston loaded their first international shipment December 13. The container was packed with 1,559 boxes of clothes, blankets, linens, coats, hygiene kits along with 10 bicycles. It was then transported to the Port of Houston where it will be shipped to South Africa. Jesus' Footprints in Africa Ministry will receive the shipment and then share the Good News of Jesus as they distribute these blessings to people who do not have the means to provide for themselves. OGT Board members are grateful for the continued support of individuals, churches, and community groups who bring donations, volunteer, and offer financial gifts to fulfill our mission as we provide aid for orphans, widows and those less fortunate. 
OGT Michigan Provides Care

Weekly Devotion

Surely God is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid. The Lord, the Lord, is my strength and my song; He has become my salvation . . . Sing to the Lord, for He has done glorious things; let this be known to all the world. Shout aloud and sing for joy, people of Zion, for great is the Holy One of Israel among you. (Is. 12:2, 5-6)

Strength: If you're a baseball fan, you may remember the excitement that accompanied Mark McGuire and Sammy Sosa as they chased the single-season home run record in 1998. Both broke the record, and McGuire ultimately came out on top, but their efforts were tainted when it came out that both had used performance-enhancing drugs. They weren't the last athletes who were tainted because they used such drugs.

In case you're wondering, it's possible to increase your strength by using steroids and other similar drugs. Not only does this give some athletes an unfair advantage, there are serious health risks associated with these drugs, and they are rightfully banned. We're talking about physical strength, but the Bible talks about a different kind of strength. The prophet Isaiah writes, "The Lord, the Lord, is my strength and my song; He has become my salvation."

Performance-enhancing drugs may provide physical strength, but

the effects are not permanent, and these effects may be detrimental. God's strength, however, is the power of forgiveness and salvation. It is His power that saves us from the assaults of Satan. This spiritual strength, which is anything but detrimental, creates eternal effects and benefits. "(The Lord) has done glorious things."

We shout aloud and sing for joy, O Lord, for You have become our salvation. Amen.
